The grandeur of Jesus' promise — "if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed" - is overlooked in our time of affluence and arrogance. The mantra, "I'm free! I live in a free country. I'm an American," reminds us of the overconfidence of the Pharisees who sought criticism against the Lord in John's eighth chapter.

Objecting to Jesus' pleading, "If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples, and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free," His critics chided, "We are offspring of Abraham and have never been enslaved to anyone. How is it that you say, You will become free," John 8:31-32. Could these hacks have been more oblivious to their own history? Had they purged the story of the Egyptian slavery, reducing it to a mere sojourn? Misstating their history was a small thing. They were actively plotting Jesus' murder — "a man who has told you the truth," 8:40. It is true that WE live in a nation that enjoys un-

paralleled freedom. But that freedom, like a serpent, has risen to bite then enslave the very people who are living under its umbrella. The critic asks, "How so? Am I not free?" Pay careful attention to Jesus' answer of His haughty critics to find the answer to our own need — "Truly I say to you, everyone who practices sin is a slave to sin," 8:34. America is perishing in sin.

Jesus called for believers of ALL generations to "abide in my word," 8:31. He means "don't leave. Continue to be present." Jesus distinguishes between superficial belief and discipleship. Disciples continue in His word. The result is true "freedom."

Americans, like these Jews, trust in national heritage for freedom with no attention to truth. Ancestrally the Jews were Abraham's offspring, spiritually they were in no wise kin. They served sin and it's master, the devil, 8:42-43. If America would be "free indeed" it must put off sin and seek the Son — "if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed."

Living the faithful life demands that we fill our heart so full of the word of God that it becomes the controlling force in life. This is the secret to living as we should.

KEEP THY HEART WITH ALL DILIGENCE, 23-24

A man lives out in his life what he has in his heart, "for out of it are the issues of life." If the heart is pure, the life will be pure; if the heart is corrupt, the life will be corrupt. The faithful heart is full of God's thoughts, and it will lead to a clean life, a life devoted to the service of God.

HAVE A DEFINITE AIM IN LIFE, 25-27

"Let thine eyes look right on, and let thine eyelids look straight before thee. Ponder the path of thy feet...." Set a goal before you and strive for it. Seek out a worthy purpose. Be able to say with Paul, "This one thing I do... I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus," Philippians 3:13-14. To have our hearts fully set on reaching a goal, or attaining an ideal, makes it easy to sacrifice anything that hinders. Other things seem less attractive. Both young and old will find the life of a Christian far easier to live if these three precepts are diligently applied.
